RECEIVED I/C TO RESPOND TO LISTED ADDRESS REGARDING POSSIBLE SHOTS FIRED. UPON ARRIVAL I CONTACTED R-DESOUZA, WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS THE DRIVER TO S-SPECTOR. R-DESOUZA STATED S-SPECTOR HAD A GUN AND THAT HE HAD SHOT A WOMAN INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. HE SAID HE SAW HER BODY ON THE FLOOR AND BLOOD ON HER HEAD. HE SAID HE DEFINITELY KNEW WHAT HE THOUGHT TO BE ONE GUN SHOT AND S-SPECTOR SAY TO HIM, "I THINK I KILLED HER."

MYSELF, CORP. PAGE, OFFICERS CARDELLA, HAMMOND AND TAMAYO FORMED AN ENTRY TEAM AND ENTERED THE PROPERTY. WE ENTERED THE N/E DRIVEWAY AND TOOK IT ALL THE WAY TO ITS END. WE OBSERVED WHAT WE DETERMINED TO BE THE BACK DOOR TO THE RESIDENCE. WE FIRST CLEARED A BURGANDY 4-DOOR SEDAN AND THEN ATTEMPTED TO CLEAR THE S/W GARAGE. OFC. CARDELLA STOOD BY THE DOOR TO THE GARAGE FACING NORTH TO KEEP A VISUAL ON THE RESIDENCE. OFC. TAMAYO TOOK A POSITION ON THE S/E CORNER OF THE RESIDENCE ITSELF. WHILE MYSELF, CORP. PAGE AND OFC. HAMMOND COMPLETED OUR CHECK OF THE GARAGE, OFC. CARDELLA ALERTED US VIA THE RADIO, THAT HE OBSERVED MOVEMENT ON THE SECOND STORY OF THE RESIDENCE. SOON AFTER, OFC. CARDELLA HAD COMPLETE OBSERVATION OF S-SPECTOR VIA THE SOUTH BALCONY. WE ALL FOUR THEN GATHERED AT THE GARAGE DOOR FACING NORTH.

S-SPECTOR SUDDENLY APPEARED IN THE SOUTH DOORWAY TO THE REAR OF THE RESIDENCE. OFC. CARDELLA BEGAN TO GIVE S-SPECTOR VERBAL COMMANDS. OFC. CARDELLA THEN DIRECTED S-SPECTOR TO REMOVE HIS HANDS FROM HIS POCKETS. S-SPECTOR REMAINED STILL AND QUIET. HE THEN WENT BACK INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. AGAIN, OFC. CARDELLA DIRECTED S-SPECTOR TO EXIT THE DOORWAY WITH HIS HANDS IN THE AIR. S-SPECTOR APPEARED BACK IN THE DOORWAY, HOWEVER HE WAS NOT COOPERATIVE IN THAT HE CONTINUED TO IGNORE THE VERBAL COMMANDS GIVEN TO HIM. S-SPECTOR AGAIN WENT BACK INSIDE THE RESIDENCE.

1 DUE TO THE SEVERITY OF THE SITUATION AND OUR NEED TO CHECK ON
2 ANY INJURED PERSONS INSIDE THE RESIDENCE, WE FOLLOWED S-SPECTOR
3 INTO THE RESIDENCE. S-SPECTOR THEN TURNED TO FACE US. AT THAT
4 TIME, CORP. PAGE TASED S-SPECTOR TO DISABLE HIM AFTER ALL
5 VERBAL COMMANDS HAD FAILED. S-SPECTOR CONTINUED STANDING AS IF
6 THE TASER HAD NO EFFECT ON HIM. OFFICER CARDELLA THEN RUSHED
7 S-SPECTOR USING THE SHIELD TO STRIKE HIM AND KNOCK HIM OFF HIS FEET.
8 OFC. HAMMOND THEN CUFFED S-SPECTOR TO SECURE HIM WHILE WE
9 CONTINUED TO SEARCH THE RESIDENCE.

11 UPON ENTERING THE FOYER, I OBSERVED ONE FEMALE ADULT TO MY
12 RIGHT, SHE APPEARED TO BE SITTING ON A CHAIR FACING FORWARD.
13 SHE WAS LIGHT COMPLECTED WITH BLOND HAIR AND WAS BLEEDING
14 ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HER HEAD. OFC. CARDELLA CHECKED HER FOR
15 ANY SIGNS OF LIFE. HE STATED SHE HAD NO PULSE AND WAS COLD TO
16 HIS TOUCH. THERE WAS A SMALL REVOLVER NEAR HER LEFT FOOT

18 I THEN PROCEEDED TO CLEAR THE LOWER LEVEL OF THE WEST WING
19 OF THE RESIDENCE. AS I PROCEEDED TO DO SO, I HEARD S-SPECTOR
20 YELLING "WHAT'S WRONG WITH YOU GUYS?" "WHAT ARE YOU DOING?"
21 AS I CONTINUED WITH MY SEARCH, AGAIN I HEARD S-SPECTOR
22 YELL, "I DIDN'T MEAN TO SHOOT HER, IT WAS AN ACCIDENT," "I HAVE
23 AN EXPLANATION FOR THIS." OFC. CARDELLA THEN JOINED ME AND WE
24 COMPLETED OUR SEARCH OF THE LOWER LEVEL OF THE WEST WING.

26 AS OTHER UNITS ARRIVED TO ASSIST, OFC. CARDELLA, MYSELF AND
27 CORP. PAGE THEN PROCEEDED TO THE UPPER LEVEL VIA THE STAIRWAY
28 TO CONTINUE OUR SEARCH. WHEN WE REACHED THE TOP OF THE
29 STAIRWAY, WE WORKED OUR WAY FROM WEST TO EAST CONDUCTING
30 A SYSTEMATIC SEARCH FROM ROOM TO ROOM. ONCE WE DETERMINED
31 THE UPPER LEVEL TO BE SECURE, WE RETURNED TO THE LOWER
32 TO CONTINUE OUR INVESTIGATION.
